Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

What do people really value? For many, it may be their family, or personal security. Others may value wealth, or personal rights, or their reputation. Still others may value power and influence. Take a moment to think about what you value most.

Today's first reading shows God praising King Solomon for placing value not on wealth and riches, but on wisdom to know what is right, that he might govern people well. In the Gospel, Jesus speaks of the Kingdom as the greatest treasure, something to be prized above all else—to be sought as keenly as the buried treasure in the field, or the pearl of great price.

Today, Jesus is calling us to seek what matters most—to seek a deeper spiritual life, lived by God's values, lived for the kingdom. That will never mean we ignore our daily responsibilities or the rights of others, because Jesus calls us to serve others in love, to live with compassion, and to work for justice.


What we value matters. What we value leads our hearts and determines our actions. Our values need to be joined to Christ. We can count on getting it right when we work for his Kingdom, not for our own!





Finding Buried Treasure

Much like still-fishing, which is when the fish ultimately find the one sitting quietly waiting for the fish, most of the really treasured aspects of life somehow find us when we're not looking. Consider falling in love or discovering a friend; the job you enjoy so much that you'd almost do it for free; a hobby that gives you so much satisfaction; creative gifts you never knew you had until you stumbled upon them later in life. To say nothing of happiness for which so many go looking and never seem to find, while others are happy without ever seeking it out.

Wisdom, the gift Solomon asked for, is much like all of that. It seems to find us. Common sense, the stepchild of wisdom, is something most parents want their children to have, and, for some parents, it may be a source of great frustration as they try to make sure their children have it and use it. Wisdom is certainly a hint of the kingdom of heaven, but then so too is finding love and experiencing joy and living with a peace that refuses to be unsettled by the storms of life. All of those are the buried treasures of which the Gospel speaks, just as for others it is the pearl of great price for which they look and look until it finds them, not unlike still-fishing. All are buried treasures, hidden pearls, and tastes of eternal life. ●



La sabiduría es ciertamente un indicio del reino de los cielos, pero también lo es encontrar el amor y experimentar la alegría y vivir con una paz que se niega a ser perturbada por las tormentas de la vida. Todos esos son los tesoros escondidos de los que habla el Evangelio, igual que para otros es la perla preciosa que buscan y buscan hasta que la encuentran, no muy diferente de la pesca sin muerte. Todos son tesoros enterrados, perlas escondidas y sabores de vida eterna. ●
