## **Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco**

Dear Friends,

At this time of year, we look to have some experience of the outdoors. Some people like to go camping, getting to the woods and out under the stars. Others prefer a hotel or some other accommodations. If we cannot get away, maybe we can spend some time in one of the local parks to enjoy the blessings of nature. When the experience is a good one, we usually would like to make it last as long as possible before heading back to our usual daily routine.

The feast of the Transfiguration shows Jesus taking his disciples beyond their everyday routine, to give them a glimpse of who he really is, and even to give them a glimpse of heaven. They need it too, because journeying with Jesus is not always easy; there are trials, various obstacles they encounter along the way. And not too far down the road will be the Cross. So this moment of the Transfiguration helps them realize who Jesus is, and will sustain them on the road ahead.

In the midst of the summer, we need to remember Jesus is always with us. We may encounter glimpses of him in the beauty of nature, in a quiet time by the water or in an open field. And we are meant to encounter him whenever we come together in prayer, especially when Jesus himself joins us in the Holy Eucharist. Listen to those words spoken by the Father, and remember that **Jesus is his beloved Son...and that we too are blessed to be his beloved children!**

En esta época del año, normalmente buscamos tener alguna experiencia al aire libre. A algunas personas les gusta ir a acampar, sentarse en el bosque y ver las estrellas. Otros prefieren un hotel o algún otro tipo de alojamiento. Y si no podemos escaparnos al campo, tal vez podamos pasar un poco de tiempo en uno de los parques locales y disfrutar de las bendiciones de la naturaleza. ## The Gift of Mystery



In life there are moments that some call **transcendence**, when the divine shines through the human and the veil that seems to cloak another world falls ever so briefly to reveal that there are not two worlds but only one wrapped in mystery. That is what took place on a mountaintop when Peter, James, and John realized that this Jesus with whom they talked and walked and shared meals, this friend, this very ordinary one, was so much more, was extraordinary, was “of God.” While real, it seemed better not to tell anyone about what they had seen.

Are there also moments in our lives when the human glows with the divine, when we come to realize more clearly than ever before that there is another power at play in life than you yourself? Most assuredly. While we are powerless to create such experiences of transcendence, more than 100 years ago the psychologist William James described such moments when they do occur. He identified four qualities in such experiences: 1) they seem closer to being emotional than intellectual or cognitive; 2) they tend to bring us new understandings of life and of what is, akin to insights, though they cannot be found in a book or be taught; 3) they tend to be very brief, a few seconds for most people; and 4) there is a sense of being sustained by a superior power. This was the apostles’ experience of the transfiguration, the feast we celebrate today. ●

## El don del misterio

**E**n la vida hay momentos que algunos llaman de trascendencia, cuando lo divino brilla a través de lo humano y el velo que parece cubrir otro mundo cae brevemente para revelar que no hay dos mundos sino uno solo envuelto en misterio. Eso es lo que ocurrió en la cima de una montaña cuando Pedro, Santiago y Juan se dieron cuenta de que ese Jesús con el que hablaban y caminaban y compartían comidas, ese amigo, ese ser tan corriente, era mucho más, era extraordinario, era “de Dios”. Aunque era real, les pareció mejor no contar a nadie lo que habían visto.

¿Hay también momentos en nuestras vidas en los que lo humano resplandece con lo divino, en los que llegamos a darnos cuenta más claramente que nunca de que hay otro poder en juego en la vida que tú mismo? Sin duda. Aunque somos impotentes para crear esas experiencias de trascendencia, hace más de cien años el psicólogo William James describió esos momentos cuando se producen. Identificó cuatro cualidades en estas experiencias 1) parecen más emocionales que intelectuales o cognitivas; 2) tienden a aportarnos una nueva comprensión de la vida y de lo que es, parecida a las intuiciones, aunque no puedan encontrarse en un libro ni enseñarse; 3) tienden a ser muy breves, unos segundos para la mayoría de las personas; y 4) hay una sensación de estar sostenidos por un poder superior. Esta fue la experiencia de los apóstoles en la transfiguración, la fiesta que celebramos hoy. ●

## SUMMER SAFETY TIPS

With the “dog-days of summer” in full swing, it’s important to be aware of additional precautions needed this time of year.



- **Seek shade** to limit exposure to UV light that is strongest between 10am and 4pm.
- **Apply sunscreen** with UV protection 30 SPF or above. Wear lightweight clothing and sunglasses.
- **Wear wide-brimmed hats** to block harmful sun rays from hitting your face and scalp
- **Drink plenty of fluids** (even if you **aren't** thirsty). Dehydration is more common in summer months.
- **Check on elderly neighbors**, who may be unable to go out in high humidity and soaring temperatures, due to health limitations.
- **Limit strenuous activity** to early morning or later evening hours, when the mercury may be lower.
- **Call 311** if you suspect heat-stroke or need to find a cooling station near you.

### Con el verano en pleno apogeo, es importante tomar precauciones adicionales en esta época del año.

- **Busque la sombra** y limite la exposición a la luz ultravioleta más fuerte entre las 10 a.m. y las 4 p.m.
- **Aplicar protector solar** con protección UV 30 SPF o superior. Use ropa ligera y anteojos de sol.
- **Use sombreros de ala ancha** para evitar los dañinos rayos del sol en la cara y cuero cabelludo.
- **Beba muchos líquidos** (incluso **si no** tiene sed). La deshidratación es más común en los meses de verano.
- **Ayude a sus vecinos de edad avanzada**, quienes tal vez no puedan salir en condiciones de alta humedad y temperaturas elevadas, debido a sus limitaciones de salud.
- **Límite actividad extenuante** a temprano en la mañana o al anochecer.
- **Llame al 311** si cree que alguien sufre de sobrecalentamiento o necesita encontrar una estación de enfriamiento cerca de usted.

### A missionary priest from the Diocese of Wukari in Nigeria will speak at all the masses at Resurrection Ascension church on August 12–13



The Diocese of Wukari is currently the newest diocese in the world erected by Pope Francis on April 13, 2023, with Bishop Mark Nzukwein as its 1st Bishop. The diocese has a prospect of growth but is currently dealing with critical challenges, it faces a new beginning with very little infrastructure on the ground.

The diocese lost about 353 churches due to bandit attacks and now has many displaced parishioners in dire need. One of their churches has a student population of more than 700 who attend Mass, while the church needs a roof. Currently they worship in an open space exposed to the elements of rain and sun. The diocese also needs financial support in various areas of their mission. **If you are able, please help support them.**

### Un sacerdote misionero de la diócesis de Wukari en Nigeria hablará en todas las Misas en la iglesia de Resurrección Ascensión el 12 y 13 de agosto

La Diócesis de Wukari es actualmente la diócesis más nueva del mundo erigida por el Papa Francisco el 13 de abril de 2023, con el obispo Mark Nzukwein como su primer obispo. La diócesis tiene potencial de crecimiento, pero actualmente enfrenta desafíos críticos, por ejemplo, su inicio con muy poca infraestructura en su territorio.

La diócesis perdió alrededor de 353 iglesias debido a ataques de bandidos y ahora tiene muchos feligreses desplazados, con necesidades extremas. Una de sus iglesias tiene una población estudiantil de más de 700 que asisten a Misa, pero la iglesia aún no tiene techo. Actualmente celebran Misa en un espacio al aire libre, expuestos a la lluvia y al sol. La diócesis también necesita apoyo financiero en varias áreas de su misión.
