Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

Many have encountered difficult storms during this summer—just a few weeks ago there was heavy flooding in the Northeast, with the capital of Vermont under water, flooding in nearby Orange County New York, as well as flash flooding in the Metropolitan area affecting Connecticut, New Jersey and New York. What do people do when faced with this kind of flooding? First, they may get sump pumps working to move out some of the water; when they cannot do it all on their own, they'll seek outside help and government help to deal with the crisis.

The disciples encounter a storm while out on the water in today's Gospel. These are people who had experience with storms at sea; they have dealt with this before. But now they are in their boat without Jesus, and they are filled with fear. In the midst of the storm, Jesus comes to them on the water. Soon enough, the scene changes, the waters are calm and Jesus is with them.

Can you relate? How many times do we feel that way? But as much as the storms associated with the weather can threaten our lives and livelihood, our inner storms caused by fear and doubt may threaten our spiritual peace even more. **When doubts and fears affect our faith, we need the certainty that Jesus will come to our aid.** As we continue to navigate these stormy times, we can seek out God's voice in the midst of chaos, of fear, in the midst of it all. We reach out for Jesus' hand as Peter does in the Gospel, and He comes in our rescue. We can be certain that just as Jesus came to the aid of his disciples that day in the boat, so too, Jesus is near to us at all times.

**Jesús vendrá en
nuestra ayuda**

Muchos hemos experimentado duras tormentas durante este verano: hace solo unas semanas hubo fuertes inundaciones en el noreste, la capital de Vermont bajo de agua, inundaciones en el cercano condado de Orange, Nueva York, así como inundaciones repentina en el área metropolitana que afectó a Connecticut, Nueva Jersey y Nueva York. ¿Qué hace la gente cuando se enfrenta a este tipo de inundaciones? Primero, pueden utilizar bombas de extracción para sacar parte del agua; pero, cuando no pueden hacerlo solos, buscarán ayuda externa y ayuda del gobierno para enfrentar la crisis.

Los discípulos se encuentran con una tormenta mientras están navegando mar adentro en el Evangelio de hoy. Ellos tenían experiencia con esta clase tormentas en el mar de Galilea; han tenido que afrontarlas anteriormente. Pero ahora, están en su barca sin Jesús, y están llenos de miedo. En medio de la tormenta, Jesús se acerca a ellos sobre el agua. Muy pronto, la escena cambia, las aguas se tranquilizan y Jesús ya está con ellos.

¿Cuántas veces nos pasa eso a nosotros? Pero por mucho que las tormentas asociadas con el clima puedan amenazar nuestras vidas y nuestro sustento, nuestras tormentas internas causadas por el miedo y la duda pueden amenazar nuestra paz espiritual aún más. **Cuando las dudas y los miedos afectan nuestra fe, necesitamos tener la certeza de que Jesús vendrá en nuestra ayuda.** Al continuar navegando en estos tiempos tormentosos, podemos buscar la voz de Dios en medio del caos, del temor, en medio de todo. Extendemos nuestra mano a Jesús como lo hace Pedro en el Evangelio y Él nos rescata. Podemos estar plenamente seguros de que al igual que Jesús vino en ayuda de sus discípulos ese día en la barca, así también, Jesús estará cerca de nosotros en todo momento.

As priests we're expected to plan our own funerals, including the Scripture readings. As it happens, I chose the Gospel for this Sunday, the one about Jesus walking across the water and inviting Peter to trust and step out of the boat and come to him. You may think it strange for a funeral, but it's been pretty much the story of my life.

Often there have been times when I was asked to go where I didn't want to go, like Peter being asked to get out of the boat. Ultimately I realized that those were also the very times when I seemed most aware of God's presence. Oh, I think God

was always there, it's simply that my own ego often got in the way. It was when I gave in that I most felt buoyed by God. In fact, the least satisfying assignment was the one I eagerly sought out, and some of those I resisted turned out to be graced. Like Peter, it's good to do what doesn't always make sense.


What does all this have to do with my choice of this Scripture reading for my funeral? Well, every time I have stepped out of the boat of security, God has been there to sustain me. I figure there is going to be no bigger "stepping out" than death, so I'm expecting God will be there as well. ●

¿Qué tiene que ver todo esto con la elección de esta lectura de las Escrituras para mi funeral? Bueno, cada vez que he salido del barco de la seguridad, Dios ha estado ahí para sostenerme. Me imagino que no habrá mayor “salida” que la muerte, así que espero que Dios también esté allí. ●


Para reflexionar
