Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

Most of us enjoy a nice get together with friends or family. Most of us enjoy parties. We may enjoy them for the food, or maybe for the company, and often for both. Sharing a meal with people, especially a festive meal around a joyous occasion, can bring us great joy!

Today's Scriptures picture heaven as a wedding banquet for the king's son. All the proper invitations are sent out—but the response is puzzling. The invited guests refuse to come! They are either too busy or are just not interested in coming. In the end, the King insists on inviting whoever could be found to fill his banquet. Certainly, this parable tells us of God's great desire to share his feast with everyone, to welcome all to the feast of the Kingdom. We have a foretaste of the Heavenly banquet every time we gather for the Holy Eucharist. Here, too, we know that many are invited, but some choose not to come.

Here is the hard part. Are we ever the ones to reject the invitation; or, worse yet, are we ever the ones who look around at our neighbors and think "they don't belong here"? Ultimately, we are called to be God's messengers today, to invite others to join in the banquet; we are to be a people who welcome others to celebrate the joy of God's love.

As the Synod on Synodality continues to meet in Rome, we pray that the Holy Spirit will guide the members of the synod to listen attentively to one another, and to be open to the promptings of the Spirit. May the work of the Synod help the Church to lead others to the banquet of God's love!

Tal vez sea que están demasiado ocupados o simplemente no están interesados en venir. Al final, el Rey insiste en invitar a quien sea que encuentren para llenar su banquete. Ciertamente esta parábola nos habla del gran deseo de Dios de compartir su fiesta con todos, de acoger a todos en la festividad del Reino. Cada vez que nos reunimos para la Sagrada Eucaristía experimentamos un anticipo del banquete celestial. También aquí sabemos que muchos están invitados, pero algunos optan por no venir.

Aquí está la parte difícil. ¿Somos alguna vez nosotros quienes rechazamos la invitación? O peor aún, ¿alguna vez somos nosotros los que miramos a nuestro prójimo y pensamos "y este que hace aquí?, no pertenece a esta comunidad." En última instancia, hoy estamos llamados a ser mensajeros de Dios para invitar a otros a unirse al banquete; debemos ser un pueblo que acoge a otros para celebrar el gozo del amor de Dios.

Al reunirse el Sínodo sobre la Sinodalidad en Roma, nosotros oramos para que el Espíritu Santo guíe a los miembros del sínodo a escucharse atentamente unos a otros y a estar abiertos a la inspiración del Espíritu. ¡Que los trabajos del Sínodo ayuden a la Iglesia a llevar a otros al banquete del amor de Dios!

We need you, opportunities for ministry abound and we can use some extra help.



semana tras semana?**



Yes or No?

Confronted by a social obligation I would prefer to avoid, I frequently find myself musing that the timing is right for me to break a leg or get the flu. Yet more often than not, once I go, I find myself enjoying the gathering. Not all invitations are exciting or even desirable, but many become the building blocks of our lives.

When the parable of Jesus tells of an invitation to come to a wedding feast, it's really a story of our invitation to the kingdom of heaven, where, if we accept, we will dwell in the divine presence and enjoy the peace, joy, and love of God. Heaven is not only *where* we are but also *how* we are. It's an invitation to deeper and richer life—a taste of heaven, even in this life.

So it's good to consider going where we'd rather not

go. It's not simply about social gatherings, though a social gathering may be the event where you meet the person you fall in love with. It also may mean going for counseling when that may be a bit scary, or confronting one's addiction, or moving to a new city, or accepting serious and lifelong illness, or saying yes to having a child with special needs, or not getting the job you hoped for. Saying yes to what life brings may be the wedding garment that enriches our lives. It may be saying yes to God. ●

Ante una obligación social que preferiría evitar, a menudo me encuentro pensando que es el momento oportuno para romperme una pierna o contraer la gripe. Sin embargo, la mayoría de las veces, una vez que acudo, me encuentro disfrutando de la reunión. No todas las invitaciones son emocionantes, ni siquiera deseables, pero muchas se convierten en los cimientos de nuestras vidas.

Cuando la parábola de Jesús habla de una invitación para acudir a un banquete de bodas, en realidad es una historia de nuestra invitación al reino de los cielos, donde, si aceptamos, moraremos en la presencia divina y disfrutaremos de la paz, la alegría y el amor de Dios. El cielo no es sólo *dónde* estamos, sino también *cómo* estamos. Es una invitación a una vida más profunda y más rica: a saborear el cielo, incluso en esta vida.

Por eso es bueno plantearse ir donde preferiríamos no ir. No se trata simplemente de reuniones sociales, aunque una reunión social puede ser el acontecimiento en el que conoces a la persona de la que te enamoras. También puede significar ir a terapia cuando eso puede dar un poco de miedo, o enfrentarse a la propia adicción, o mudarse a una nueva ciudad, o aceptar una enfermedad grave y de por vida, o decir sí a tener un hijo con necesidades especiales, o no conseguir el trabajo que esperabas. Decir sí a lo que nos trae la vida puede ser el traje de novia que enriquezca nuestras vidas. Puede ser decir sí a Dios. ●
