Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

Looking at recent events in the Holy Land, we see how terrorism and war disrupt the lives of so many. So many lives were lost in the early days of the war; so many more lives have been lost, and so many people displaced, as the days have turned into weeks of war. We need to pray daily for peace, for an end to the hostilities, and for freedom for those who are held hostage. As we are reminded by Pope Francis, “wars are always a defeat.” May peace come to Israel and to Gaza!

In this week's Gospel, the double commandment to love God and love our neighbor is as important to hear as ever! Jesus is giving a simple summary of the 613 laws of the Torah—but being simple does not make it easy to put into practice. Loving God with “heart, soul and mind” means our dedication to God goes beyond a surface attraction. We acknowledge the Lord God as Lord of our lives, meriting our total devotion. Then, to love our neighbor as ourselves becomes the proof of our love for God. It shows that we put into action the love of God—who is creator of all our brothers and sisters as well. In times of war and conflict, this is too easy to forget or set aside. However challenging it may be at times, may we serve God and our neighbor with all our heart, and may we love them as ourselves!

Al observar los acontecimientos recientes en Tierra Santa, vemos cómo el terrorismo y la guerra impactan las vidas de tantas personas. Han fallecido muchas personas en los primeros días de la guerra; se han perdido muchas más vidas y muchas personas han sido desplazadas, a medida que los días se han convertido en semanas de guerra. Muestra que ponemos en práctica el amor de Dios, quien también es creador de todos nuestros hermanos y hermanas. En tiempos de guerra y conflicto, esto es muy fácil de olvidar o dejar a un lado. Pero, por muy desafiante que sea a veces, ¡debemos servir a Dios y a nuestro prójimo con todo nuestro corazón y amarlos como a nosotros mismos!

The Other Side of Love

Dennis is one of the local street people who lives around the parish where I live. He is usually pleasant and courteous and wants to do things right, though he also struggles with his own set of demons. For the most part, Dennis seems to be finding his way through the mazes of life, as people do in their own fashion.

In some ways, the parishioners have become a family for Dennis, or at least a part of the family scattered about the neighborhood. Frequently he will be gone for a time, and we will wonder what happened to Dennis, only to find him drifting back among us.

These days Dennis is angry with us. For whatever reason, Dennis brought his assembled belongings and took up residence on our garage roof. The roof is flat and has a two-foot-high wall around the edge, a place that affords a bit of shelter from the wind. Soon, however, the parish came up with a list of reasons why it would be best if Dennis did not live on our garage roof—safety, security, and insurance among them. So Dennis was asked to move on, and that's why Dennis is angry with us.

The parish staff tries to be sensitive and caring about the street people. They try to let them make their own way when that is what they want to do. Yet at other times the staff needs to do what is best for everyone involved in the parish. It's not always easy to know how to love someone. ●

Pronto, sin embargo, la parroquia elaboró una lista de razones por las que sería mejor que Dennis no viviera en el tejado del garaje, entre ellas la seguridad y el seguro. Así que se pidió a Dennis que se mudara, y por eso Dennis está enfadado con nosotros.

El personal de la parroquia intenta ser sensible y cariñoso con la gente de la calle. Intentan dejarles que hagan su propio camino cuando eso es lo que quieren hacer. Pero otras veces el personal tiene que hacer lo que es mejor para todos los implicados en la parroquia. No siempre es fácil saber cómo amar a alguien. ●




All Saints Holy Day
