





December 12th is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Let's review her story. The Virgin Mary first introduced herself as the Mother of God and the mother of all humanity when she appeared on the hill of Tepeyac in Mexico in 1531. An indigenous peasant, Juan Diego, saw a glowing figure on the hill. After she had identified herself to him, Our Lady asked that Juan build her a shrine in that same spot, so she could show and share her love and compassion with all those who believe. Juan Diego told the Archbishop of Mexico City. He dismissed him in disbelief and asked that he provide proof of his story and proof of the Lady's identity.

Juan Diego returned to the hill and encountered Our Lady again. On December 12th, in her last appearance to Juan Diego, she ordered him to gather some unseasonable roses from the top of a mountain and bring them to the Archbishop as proof of her request to have a church built there. When Juan Diego let the roses fall out of his tilma (poncho), the miraculous image of Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared imprinted on his tilma, and the Archbishop was convinced. This actual tilma, preserved since that date and showing the familiar image of the Virgin Mary with her head bowed and hands together in prayer, has been venerated by millions of people every year. The Virgin of Guadalupe was declared Queen of Mexico and is Patroness of the Americas.

During the fourth apparition on December 12th Our Lady said to Juan Diego:

**“Hear me and understand well, my child, that nothing should frighten or grieve you.
Let not your heart be troubled. Do not fear any sickness or anguish.**

**Am I not here? And am I not your Mother? Are you not under my protection? Am I not your health?
Are you not within my embrace? What else do you wish? Do not grieve nor be disturbed by anything.”**

***The Virgin Mary's maternal words to Juan Diego continue to echo in the hearts of all those who love her.
Let us open our hearts to her loving care. Our Lady of Guadalupe, pray for us..***
