

Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro párroco

Dear Friends,

Today's feast of Christ the King invites us to picture Jesus reigning in glory on his heavenly throne. We picture Jesus as the just judge of us all. The ultimate question raised by this scene is simple: What are we doing for our brothers and sisters, the “least ones”? How are you and I treating our neighbors in need? For Jesus tells us clearly that, **“Whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me.”**

The Gospel of Jesus, our faith as followers of Jesus, has undeniable social implications. It challenges the way we live, what we watch on television, how we share what we have with others, the kind of concern we show for the environment, the commitment we have to respect for life, and even the decisions we make with regard to war and peace. All of our daily decisions will be judged by the way we treat our neighbors. And if we heed this Gospel, and put into practice the corporal works of mercy, then we show to the world that Christ the King of the Universe also reigns in our hearts! That means setting sin and selfishness aside to serve Christ in our brothers and sisters. Chapter twenty-five of the gospel of Matthew invites us to a profound reflection on our lives; **how do I live out this Gospel on a daily basis?**

As we prepare next weekend to enter the Season of Advent, may we look for opportunities to reach out and serve Christ in our neighbor.

El capítulo veinticinco del evangelio de San Mateo nos invita a una reflexión muy profunda sobre nuestra vida; **¿Cómo pongo en práctica este Evangelio en mi vida diaria?**

December 12th is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Let's review her story. The Virgin Mary first introduced herself as the Mother of God and the mother of all humanity when she appeared on the hill of Tepeyac in Mexico in 1531. An indigenous peasant, Juan Diego, saw a glowing figure on the hill. After she had identified herself to him, Our Lady asked that Juan build her a shrine in that same spot, so she could show and share her love and compassion with all those who believe. Juan Diego told the Archbishop of Mexico City. He dismissed him in disbelief and asked that he provide proof of his story and proof of the Lady's identity.

Juan Diego returned to the hill and encountered Our Lady again. On December 12th, in her last appearance to Juan Diego, she ordered him to gather some unseasonable roses from the top of a mountain and bring them to the Archbishop as proof of her request to have a church built there. When Juan Diego let the roses fall out of his tilma (poncho), the miraculous image of Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared imprinted on his tilma, and the Archbishop was convinced. This actual tilma, preserved since that date and showing the familiar image of the Virgin Mary with her head bowed and hands together in prayer, has been venerated by millions of people every year. The Virgin of Guadalupe was declared Queen of Mexico and is Patroness of the Americas.

During the fourth apparition on December 12th Our Lady said to Juan Diego:

“Hear me and understand well, my child, that nothing should frighten or grieve you.

Let not your heart be troubled. Do not fear any sickness or anguish.

**Am I not here? And am I not your Mother? Are you not under my protection? Am I not your health?
Are you not within my embrace? What else do you wish? Do not grieve nor be disturbed by anything.”**

***The Virgin Mary's maternal words to Juan Diego continue to echo in the hearts of all those who love her.
Let us open our hearts to her loving care. Our Lady of Guadalupe, pray for us..***






