

Family Gifts

I asked some folks what they carried with them as their most treasured gift from their parents. One spoke of the gift of freedom. As an adult he always felt loved and welcomed by his parents. Although he was not always able to visit them as frequently as his life would allow, he was never made to feel guilty about it. It was an atmosphere unpressured by any “have-tos” whether it concerned choices for marriage or profession or simply for occasional family visits.

Another spoke of being taught by example that love in a family always extends to welcoming the stranger, caring for the unfortunate, opening one’s home to those in pain. She learned to live that way because that was how her parents lived.

Yet another spoke of her father’s gentleness and faithfulness as treasured gifts. And in truth she herself had become gentle and faithful, both with life and with God. Yet another took note of his parents’ acceptance and openness to differing cultures and traditions and value systems. It was a way of living he now took to himself and his own family.

Not every family may seem as graced as these individuals remember their own families, and no doubt these families had flaws, too. Yet those qualities of a believer, enumerated by St. Paul in his Letter to the Colossians, make for good family life as well: “heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another. And over all these put on love” (Colossians 3:12–14). ●

Regalos familiares

Pregunté a algunas personas qué llevaban consigo como regalo más preciado de sus padres. Uno habló del don de la libertad. De adulto, siempre se sintió querido y acogido por sus padres. Aunque no siempre podía visitarlos con la frecuencia que su vida le permitía, nunca le hicieron sentirse culpable por ello. Era un ambiente sin presiones de ningún tipo, ya se tratara de elecciones matrimoniales o profesionales, o simplemente de visitas familiares ocasionales.

Otra habló de que le enseñaron con el ejemplo que el amor en una familia siempre se extiende a acoger al forastero, a cuidar de los desafortunados, a abrir la propia casa a los que sufren. Aprendió a vivir así porque así vivían sus padres.

Otra hablaba de la dulzura y la fidelidad de su padre como dones preciados. Y, en verdad, ella misma se había vuelto gentil y fiel, tanto con la vida como con Dios. Otro tomó nota de la aceptación y la apertura de sus padres a culturas, tradiciones y sistemas de valores diferentes. Era una forma de vivir que ahora adoptaba para sí mismo y para su propia familia.

Puede que no todas las familias parezcan tan agraciadas como estas personas recuerdan a sus propias familias, y sin duda estas familias también tenían defectos. Sin embargo, las cualidades de un creyente, enumeradas por San Pablo en su Carta a los Colosenses, también contribuyen a una buena vida familiar: "compasión sincera, bondad, humildad, mansedumbre y paciencia, soportándodos unos a otros y perdonándodos unos a otros. Y sobre todo esto revestíos de amor" (Colosenses 3:12-14). ●
