Letter from our Pastor—Carta de nuestro Párroco

Dear Friends,

Where are we on the road following Jesus?

The Gospel finds Jesus beginning his ministry and calling people to repentance and a change of heart. Then he calls his first disciples, Simon and Andrew, James and John. They already had their “calling:” they were in the family business of fishing. But Jesus calls them to something more! They are to be his first disciples, and they will be casting their nets in a totally new way, fishing for people. Can we imagine what it was like for them to leave behind their fishing nets to follow Jesus? It had to be hard, because this was their livelihood. But there was something about Jesus that led them to trust him. His message was urgent: “the kingdom of God is at hand,” and so they dropped everything to follow him. **Once Jesus entered their lives, everything seemed to change.**

On the road with Jesus, we too are meant to let him change our lives as we embrace his message and take up his mission. We too are called to learn from him; we too are called to serve him, both at home and with our neighbors; we too are called to help others discover the Good News of Christ. For in him we will find our deepest calling and our deepest fulfillment!

¿En dónde nos encontramos en el camino siguiendo a Jesús?



A New World Is Coming

Our lives are filled with calls of one kind or another. Phone calls, text messages, teachers who call on us in class, those who call us for supper, people behind a counter who call out, “Next!” And, sooner or later, death will call each of us.

Jonah was once called to go to Nineveh, and the people of Nineveh were called to repent and change their lives. Simon and Andrew, John and James were called to follow Jesus. And today God calls each of us, but it is never easy to sort out what it is we are called to do.

Saint Paul took pains to tell us that “the world in its present form is passing away” (1 Corinthians 7:31). That being true, then God’s call is always into a new way of life, which seems to imply leaving something behind, not unlike the four followers in Sunday’s Gospel leaving their fishing nets and their father Zebedee in his boat.

The world that is passing away may be childhood, or productivity as we age. The new world may require confronting addiction and leaving a life of what we thought we couldn’t live without. Or, like the people of Nineveh who were called to repent, it might be a call for our nation to confront our failure to engage in dialogue about and find solutions to injustice in its many forms at home and abroad. Who knows what God’s new world will be? ●

El nuevo mundo puede requerir enfrentarse a la adicción y dejar una vida en la que creíamos que no podíamos vivir sin ella. O, como el pueblo de Nínive, que fue llamado al arrepentimiento, puede ser una llamada a nuestra nación para que se enfrente a nuestra incapacidad para dialogar y encontrar soluciones a la injusticia en sus múltiples formas, tanto en casa como en el extranjero. ¿Quién sabe cómo será el nuevo mundo de Dios? ●
