How easy it is to look at others and see their scars, their faults, and their failings. We look and we tend to judge. Sometimes it can be that automatic—we don't even notice what we are doing. Our ability to judge is a gift that we misuse too often as we act as if we can judge the whole person. Only God can do that.

In this Sunday's Gospel scene, we can imagine how people shunned the leper. It was the common response. How different are the actions of Jesus. Jesus does not shun the leper; rather, he touches him and heals him. Do we realize that we too have the power to bring healing, if instead of shunning others, we would welcome the stranger and those who are different, the ones whom the world considers outcasts?


As we prepare to enter into the holy season of Lent, may God's love open us up to look upon all those we meet as our sisters and brothers.

Qué fácil es mirar a los demás y ver sus cicatrices, sus faltas y sus fracasos. Miramos y tendemos a juzgar. A veces lo hacemos automáticamente: ni siquiera nos damos cuenta de lo que estamos haciendo. Nuestra capacidad de juzgar es un don que utilizamos incorrectamente con demasiada frecuencia cuando actuamos como si pudiéramos juzgar a la persona en su totalidad. Sólo Dios puede hacer eso.

En la escena del Evangelio de este domingo podemos imaginar cómo la gente rechazaba al leproso. Esa era la respuesta común de aquella época. Cuán diferentes son las acciones de Jesús. Jesús no rechaza al leproso; más bien, lo toca y lo cura. ¿Y nosotros, nos damos cuenta de que también tenemos el poder de ofrecer sanación, si en lugar de rechazar a los demás, acogiéramos a los extraños y a aquellos que son diferentes a nosotros, a aquellos que el mundo considera marginados?

Ahora, al prepararnos para entrar en la temporada santa de la Cuaresma, pidamos para que el amor de Dios nos abra los ojos y el corazón y para que consideremos a todos aquellos que encontramos en nuestro camino como nuestros hermanos y hermanas en Cristo.



**Regulations for Lent:** All Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday are bound to abstain entirely from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and all Fridays during Lent. All Catholics between the ages of 18 - 59 inclusive are also bound to observe the law of fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (only one full meal on those days).

**Regulaciones de Cuaresma:** Todos los católicos que han cumplido los 14 años de edad están obligados a abstenerse por completo de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo y todos los viernes durante la Cuaresma. 
