That's really what we're all supposed to be about as Christians. As the journey of Lent continues, we are trying to get a clearer picture of Jesus as we pray, make sacrifices, and reach out to others. But not only that—by the way we live, we are also meant to become a clearer image of Jesus to the brothers and sisters we meet day by day.

It's a great way to commemorate the Passion, Death and Resurrection of our Lord, as we open our hearts more and more to his love and mercy as we begin Holy Week!
