It has been helpful for me, over the years, to meet with other people in small group formats to talk about my faith. When I was a young adult I was in a group that met 2x a month and to have that sharing with others in my life back then – where we talked about faith in the context of our daily lives -- was invaluable. Today I meet with a group of priests, and we talk about our faith in the context of our daily experience of being parish priests.

Coming to Mass is a beautiful thing – for to gather, as Jesus asked us to do – to hear God’s word and to pray together and to receive Jesus’s Body and Blood are blessings which are hard to fathom they are so beautiful. But to be able to talk in a more personal way about our faith with others and to hear how others handle the events of their lives with the help of their faith can be very, very helpful and sometimes can make all the difference in our lives of faith.

All our groups have leaders who are trained, and we work on creating environments in our small groups where all people have a chance to share (if they want to share) and we try to make sure the conversation isn’t dominated by a few individuals or gets off-topic.
