Dear Friends,

There has been another rash of email, phone, and text message phishing scams recently. With the email and text scams, people will receive a message saying something like: "Dear (your name). How are you? I need you to do me a favor. Please contact me as soon as possible. Thanks, Rev. Brent / or Pastor Brent." **THESE TYPES OF MESSAGES ARE SCAMS!!!** You should not respond back to them, but if you did, the person claiming to be "me" or another parish staff member would then probably ask you to go and buy a bunch of gift cards. Once the gift cards are purchased, the scammer would then ask you to give him/her the numbers on the back of the card. Once they have the numbers, they have the money on the card. **PLEASE DO NOT FALL VICTIM TO THESE TYPES OF SCAMS.**



If you receive one of these emails or texts you can frequently report it through your email or text message app. You should also report it to the Federal Trade Commission at <https://reportfraud.ftc.gov/#/>.

The criminals perpetrating these scams are very good at what they do. They will often make it sound like the parish (or another organization, even a family member) is collecting money for a charity or might be in need of emergency help. They are able to spoof phone numbers and email addresses so they look legitimate.

The parish will not contact you about raising money without first announcing it at Mass, in the bulletin,

or on the parish website. If you have any doubts about a message you receive from "us", please contact the

parish directly--don't reply to the suspicious email or text because the person at the other end is the scammer. Call the parish directly at 541-482-1146.

With the holidays approaching, these types of scams are probably going to become more common so stay alert and don't be a victim of these crimes.

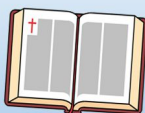

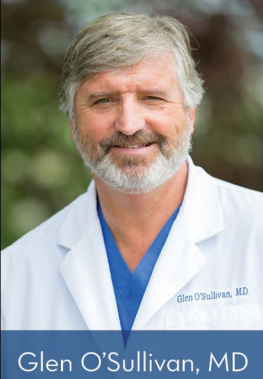
