Solar Project Opportunity - Thanks to generous donations from parishioners and an allocation from the parish maintenance fund, the outstanding solar panel project financial requirement has been lowered from \$84,331 to \$9,624 currently. There is a possibility of an additional one thousand dollar grant. With a hope of finishing the need, some members of the Care for Creation/Laudato si' ministry have pledged a one to one match of further funds donated by parishioners before December 28, 2021. To qualify for the match, donations should be made to the parish office by mail, in person at the office, or in the secure drop box outside the parish office. Donations need to arrive before Dec. 28. They must be designated by note or memo line to Solar Project or Care for Creation. The match will be capped once the goal of the outstanding stated deficit has been reached or on December 28, whichever

comes first. This is a great opportunity to begin to lower monthly costs to the parish and to respond to Pope Francis' call to lower our impact on God' creation.
