Confessions will not be heard on Christmas Day which falls on a Saturday this year, so the final scheduled opportunity for Confessions will be Saturday, December 18 -- do not wait until the last minute!

With Christmas falling on Saturday this year, both Saturday **AND** Sunday are Holy Days of obligation; please pay close attention to the Christmas Mass schedule posted in the bulletin, on the website, and on the doors of the church. Overflow seating will be available in the parish hall. Have a blessed Advent season.

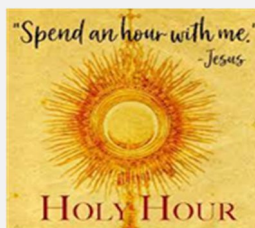

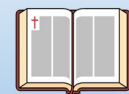
