Dear Friends.

As was mentioned at the end of Mass last weekend, there will be some extra opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration and Confessions during Advent. On the next two Fridays (December



10 and 17), I will be available for Confessions in the Church from 6 - 8 PM; we will also be having Eucharistic Adoration during these times. Please keep in mind that these are <u>NOT</u> the communal penance services with multiple priests; due to the ongoing pandemic it was decided not to have those services this year. As long as everyone cooperates, is patient, and is respectful of time, things will work out fine.

In addition to the Friday Confession times, Confessions will also be heard for an extra hour on the next two Saturdays (December 11 and 18) from 2:30 - 4:30 PM. Confessions will <u>not</u> be heard on the following Saturday, December 25, because that is Christmas.

Many of you may be aware that the church is preparing for a Synod on Synodality which will happen in 2023. Simply put, synodality is discerning how the Holy Spirit is moving through and with the Body of Christ, so that we may continue to fulfill our mission to evangelize in the world. Preparation for the synod will happen in stages.

The first stage is prayer, especially before the Blessed Sacrament. Please consider taking advantage of those Friday Adoration times mentioned above and ask the Holy Spirit to guide us through this process. Also remember that the Adoration Chapel is always available; you can get the code from the office.

The next stage will most likely be "listening sessions" in parishes throughout the archdiocese. I will keep you informed about these as I get more information.

Regardless of which intentions you feel called to pray for, please make time for personal one-on-one prayer with our Lord during this

Advent season. Prayer and the scriptures are the only ways to truly get to know Christ and to recognize his voice.


