All of these books are fairly short, and I have found them to be very engaging and very enlightening. Most local booksellers should be able to help you find them, if not, just ask me and I'll point you in the right direction. Enjoy!

**Ashland Wildfire Safety Campaign** – Fire season is upon us and this month Ashland residents are asked to Be Ready to Evacuate! In order to know when to leave you will want to sign up for Nixle, the top way to receive evacuation notices. For cell phones, enter 888777 as the recipient and text 97520 in the message line. That's it. Now you are signed up for Ashland's Community Alert System and can focus on the three levels of evacuation, namely, Level 1 – Be Ready, Level 2 – Be Set and Level 3 – Go! You may also tune your radio to 1700 AM as another source of emergency information. It's important that you be ready to evacuate at a moment's notice from your home or workplace when alerted to do so. Having a "go kit" for each family member and a plan for pets and those with special needs is also important in addition to making sure your gas tank is always full. 
