Through this website you have access to a wide range of videos, movies, Bible studies, talks, books, and audiobooks that can help each of us to engage our faith at a deeper level.

I would particularly like to direct your attention to the series of videos on the sacraments. We are currently planning our adult faith formation program for the coming year, and I think it is going to focus on the sacraments. I am also planning on speaking about each of the sacraments individually--as well as the importance of Christian funerals--during my Sunday homilies.

Sometimes it helps to go back to the basics and relearn stuff that we may have forgotten. Jesus gave us these sacraments as a gift to help us get to heaven and he entrusted them to us so that we could pass them on to future generations.

There are a number of resources available to help us do this including: Bishop Barron's Word on Fire apostolate, EWTN, Ascension Press, and the incredible web-based dramatic television series "Chosen."

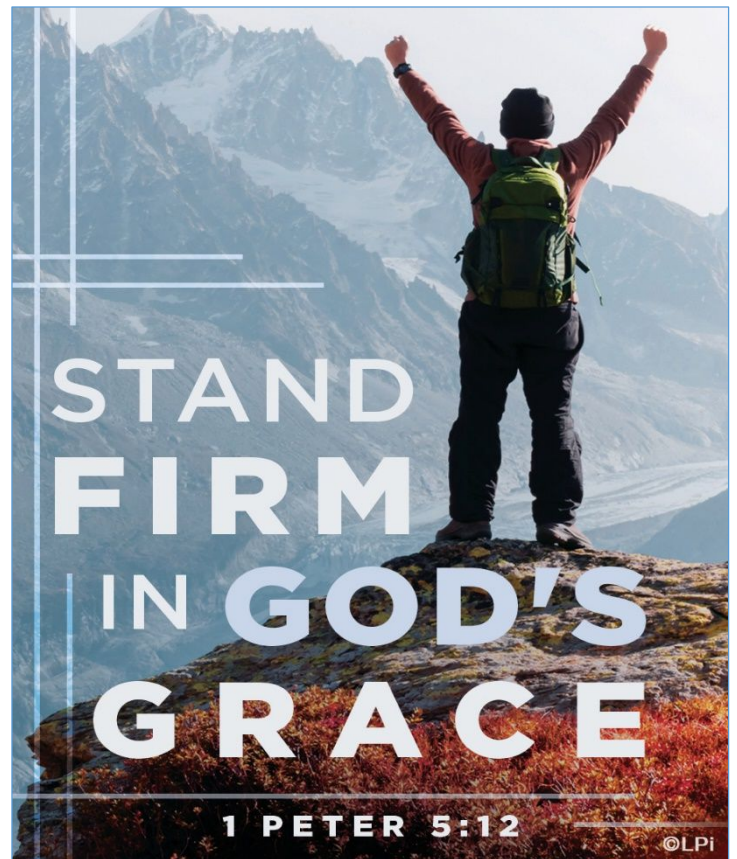

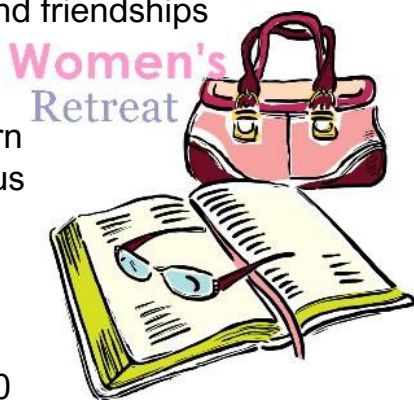
