Dear Friends.

As we all know, the State of Oregon is requiring everybody over the age of five to wear face coverings while indoors. This includes our church. You can read the statement from the Archdiocese of Portland

here: https://www.archdpdx.org/news/mask-requirements-aug-13-2021.

I am sorry to say that some members of our parish family feel that they cannot come to Mass and receive Jesus in the Eucharist because some individuals refuse to wear face coverings due to political ideology or some other reason. It is a great tragedy that one person's actions prevent another person from being united to our Lord in this way. This is a pain in the heart of Our Lord who day after day gives himself to us so that we can consume him and be united to him.

I would invite everyone who is struggling to follow the directions of the archdiocese as an act of obedience, to do it as an act of sacrifice instead. Consider face coverings a small modern version of the sackcloth and ashes used in the time of the prophets as signs of repentance. Offer the inconvenience and annoyance of face coverings as a small sacrifice on behalf of your neighbor.

Face coverings are required inside the church and other parish buildings at all times with these exceptions: choir members and cantors while singing, lectors while proclaiming the Word of God, and the faithful while receiving Holy Communion.

Priests and deacons are required to wear face coverings whenever feasible. There is also an execption for those who cannot wear a mask for legitimate health reasons...but remember, lying about a health condition is potentially a mortal sin.

The parish hall continues to be open for overflow seating for those who cannot wear masks or who would feel more comfortable around fewer people.

Please continue praying for an end to the pandemic and that we will all grow in charity towards one another.
