Next weekend, our nation will commemorate the twentieth anniversary of the tragic events of September 11, 2001. In memory of the lives lost on that day, we will observe a minute of silence during all the weekend Masses on Saturday and Sunday. In addition, at 9 am on Saturday, September 11, a special Mass will be offered to honor emergency first responders and their families, including: fire-fighters, law enforcement personnel, paramedics and other emergency medical personnel, correctional officers, and 911 dispatchers. Honoring those who risk--and often sacrifice--their lives in these professions is a tradition going back to the 1930's when a priest in Washington D.C. offered the first "Blue Mass." These Masses are now celebrated across the nation; since the events of September 2001, they are commonly held on the anniversary of Sept 11. Everybody is welcome to attend this Mass as a sign of gratitude towards those who risk **their lives** in order to protect **our lives**.
