Adult Faith Formation – Please join us as we walk through **The Mass** with Bp. Robert Barron in a new Word on Fire program over 6 Wednesday evenings beginning September 22nd and ending October 27th. We will see how the Mass brings us out of the fallen world and into the heavenly realm. 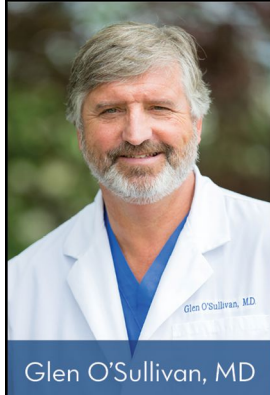
