Dear parishioners,

A quick update on the Synod on Synodality. First, keep an eye on the parish website for announcements about this process. Also, more information can be found on the archdiocesan website:

https://www.archdpdx.org/synod.

The first phase of the process was, and continues to be, prayer. Phase two will be parish discernment sessions. Our parish discernment session is tentatively planned for the afternoon of Sunday, March 6; members of both the English-speaking and Spanish-speaking communities are invited to attend.

Why is it on a Sunday? As requested by the archdiocese, each session is supposed to be 2.5 to 3 hours long. This isn't practical on a weeknight so instead, we want to hold the session when people will already be at church for Mass. More specific information about this will be available once the details are finalized.

One thing for certain is that it will begin with a Holy Hour in front of the Blessed Sacrament which will be followed by small group discussions. These discussions will be guided be guided by three questions prepared by the archdiocesan pastoral center Synod team. I plan on making the questions available MINISTRY OF CARE & SERVICE TO THE PARISH the weekend before the discernment session; the questions are already available through the archdiocese website listed above.

The next phase of the process takes place at the vicariate level in which the responses of individual parish discussions will be gathered and then sent to the archdiocese. Please continue to pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit as we continue this journey.
