I will offer a couple weeknight opportunities for Confession later in Lent; those dates and times will be announced later. Have a blessed Lenten season.

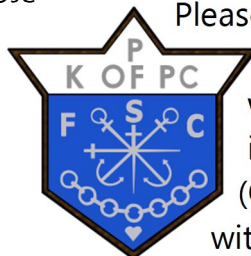

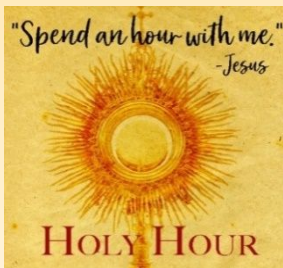
