Dear Parishioners,

Beginning next weekend, the Third Sunday of Lent, we will switch to the Cycle A readings for all of the Sunday Masses. This year we are blessed to have five people

who will receive the Sacrament of Baptism at the Easter Vigil (plus three people who will be entering full communion with the Church via the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.)

Part of the preparation for Baptism are three Rites called the Scrutinies. The Scrutinies take place on the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Sundays of Lent and they are always based on the

Cycle A series of readings. The Scrutinies are for self-searching and repentance. They are meant to uncover and heal all that is weak, wounded, and sinful in the hearts of those preparing for baptism and to strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.

The entire parish community is going to have the opportunity to journey with our Elect as they prepare for baptism in the hopes that all of us will receive the spiritual healing that we need.
