Dear Parishioners.

As part of her messages at Fatima, Our Blessed Mother asked for the First Five Saturdays Devotion, more appropriately known as the Act of Reparation to the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The

devotion consists of this: on the first Saturdays of five consecutive months, Mary has asked us to go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, pray the Rosary and spend a quarter hour meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary (Mary's request was made before St. John Paul II added the five luminous mysteries to the Rosary). In an effort to make practicing this devotion a ittle easier, I am going to experiment with the First Saturday Mass and Confession schedule. Beginning on Saturday, May 7, I will be available to hear Confessions from 8:15 - 8:45 AM. We will have the First Saturday Mass as normal at 9 AM. After Mass, I will offer the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick and then hear Confessions again until 11 am. This will mean a very busy morning for me. The tradeoff is that there will not be Confessions on First Saturday afternoons. This will hopefully give me the opportunity to go to Confession in a neighboring parish and then return for the Vigil Mass. This change will only affect the First Saturday schedule; all other Saturdays of the month will stay the same.

I sincerely hope and pray that this change will be received in a positive manner, both by all of you and by Our Blessed Mother. Our Lady of Fatima, pray for us.


