Dear Parishioners,

Everybody has probably noticed that the votive candles have been removed from the front of the church. I removed them after it was discovered that an entire matchbox had burned. All of the

matches inside the box were burned and the box itself was burned. We are not sure if this was done accidentally or on purpose but with the recent threats to Catholic churches, we are not taking any chances.

We are in the process of reviewing the security cameras inside the church to see what they can tell us about the incident. This is not the first incident involving matches and the votive candles but I intend for it to be the last.

This incident provides us with a good opportunity to review some basic safety protocols. If you encounter something or someone dangerous, call 911 immediately and then let me, Deacon Ricardo, and/or the parish staff know about it. Anytime you observe anything suspicious or seemingly out of place on the parish campus--even if it isn't an emergency--please let us know right away. For non-emergencies, an email would be appropriate. Please include the location, time, and date of what you observed; if you have photos, you can include them as well.

To further help us with security, all groups or individuals who use the parish grounds for any purpose must make sure they are signed up on the parish calendar. When I see a light on in the parish hall or church, I should be able to check the calendar and see who is in there. Please contact the office immediately to make sure your activities are on the calendar.

Finally, if you have a key to any parish buildings but are not actively involved in a ministry, please

turn in your key right away. No one is allowed to make a copy of any parish keys without prior permission from me. If a key has been assigned to you, please do not share it with anyone else without first letting the parish staff know. A key is a sign of the parish's trust in you; please do not abuse that trust. Thank you.

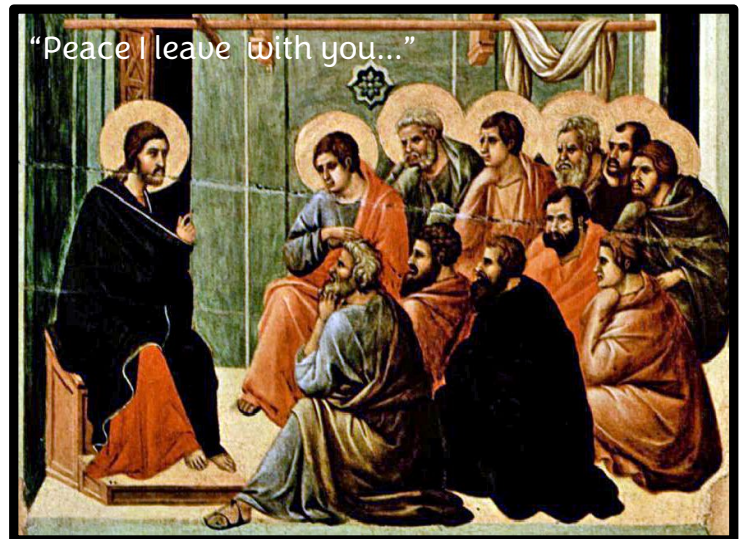
