Dear Parishioners,

It's time once again for a reminder about text and email scams. If you receive a text or email from "me" or a member of the parish staff asking you to do them a favor by going out and purchasing gift cards, it is most likely a scam. We will

never contact you in this way.

Any fundraising activities that the parish does will be announced at Mass with very specific directions on how you can participate. Scammers are getting very good at what they do by claiming the cards are for the poor or some other charitable purposes.

If you respond back to the text or email, they will then ask you for the numbers on the back of the card. Once you give them those numbers, the money is theirs. Please do not fall for this!

If you get a text or email from "me" or anyone else associated with the parish asking for money or gift cards, please contact the parish office directly; and do not reply to the email or click on any links in the email or text.

You should also report the suspicious text or email to the appropriate government agency. Information about reporting fraud and scams can be found through the following website:

https://www.usa.gov/stop-scams-frauds.

The Federal Trade Commission is the agency that collects the majority of these reports; you can call them directly at 1-877-382-4357.

Somewhat related to this is a reminder to please report if you notice anything suspicious on or near the parish grounds. If you see anything that appears to be an immediate threat call 911. Be aware and stay safe.


