Archdiocesan Seminarian Appeal – Most parishioners will receive a mailing from the Archdiocese within the next few days for the 2022 Seminarian Appeal. Appeal funds are used to help fund seminarian education and formation for seminarians sponsored by the Archdiocese of Portland. The theme of the 2022 Seminarian Appeal is, We have a Mission. As you consider your support of our Archdiocese seminarians, please reflect on Isaiah 6: 8-9, “Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send? Who will go for us?” “Here I am,” I said; “send me!” And he replied: Go and say to this people...” In this short but profound verse from Isaiah we can see three distinct actions. First, the Lord asks a question, “who will it be?” Then a brave man being open to the voice of the Lord answers, “send me”, then finally God commissions this man to “Go” to his people. For a seminarian, many are surprised to discover that from the beginning to the end of these three distinct actions it often requires seven to nine years of study and formation in the seminary until you are ordained and sent to serve in the Archdiocese of Portland. Remembering the value of the priesthood in your own sacramental life, please pray for our seminarians and please give generously to their education and formation through the Seminarian Appeal.
