"A Statement from Archbishop Sample on the passing of Pope Emeritus Benedict: I am profoundly saddened by the passing of Pope Emeritus Benedict. I personally have such deep love and esteem for him. He named me Bishop of Marquette and transferred me here to Portland just before his resignation. I greatly appreciated his prowess as an eminent theologian and scholar—a real teacher of the faith. His first encyclical, "Deus Caritas Est," is in my opinion, one of the greatest ever written. I especially appreciated his liturgical scholarship and attention to the Sacred Liturgy. I had several conversations with him about that over the years, which I treasure. I had the chance to meet him several times over the years. He granted me a private audience about one year after his resignation and it was a conversation that I will never forget. I had the opportunity to thank him for all that he has meant to me. Above all I respected his profound humility and gentleness. He was a man of deep prayer and spirituality. I will miss him dearly and now ask for his prayers of intercession."
