





How to Understand Suffering and a God who loves us.

After a reflection on the nature of God as revealed by Christ, and taking his cue from what Jesus reveals to us by His own words and works, Father's conferences will spell out the concrete steps needed in the life of every wounded Christian — Christians wounded by Original Sin and by personal sin, and in that context situate the Cross of Redemption.

any are familiar with the writings of the Catholic convert Peter Kreeft, a professor of philosophy who has written over eighty wonderful books on Christian philosophy, theology, and apologetics. In one of his books he reminds us that most of us may not be addicted to alcohol or drugs, but we are to impatience, pride, anger, lust. In other words, we are addicted to sin. Thus we can call ourselves "sinaholics." Father Emmerich will focus on the steps needed by "sinaholics" that give us access to the Eucharistic life of grace as Sacred Scripture reveals.

By leading the parishioners in an exploration of the guiding principles that lead to a deep inner peace in the midst of a troubled world, his conferences will focus on our Catholic understanding of God and the eucharistic principles needed for recovery from the effects of sin in our lives, as well as other issues of our spiritual warfare.



Fr. Emmerich is a priest of the Holy Name Province of the Dominican Order and is currently the Director of the Saint Jude Shrine at St. Dominic's Church, San Francisco, while also ministering with Western Dominican Preaching.

For the past forty-two years he has been involved in giving retreats and seminars to Mother Teresa's Priests and Sisters in Mexico, Poland, Guatemala, Uruguay, Calcutta, Madagascar, Russia, and Africa. He currently resides at St. Dominic Priory, San Francisco, CA.

IDEAS FOR GIRLS AND BOYS AGES 1-6

Warm socks, underwear, hats, mittens, small toys (big enough so they won't be a choking hazard), dolls, crayons, drawing items, scarves, small stuffed animals, puppets, booties, matchbox cars, sunglasses, hair ties, small games

IDEAS FOR GIRLS AND BOYS AGES 7-14

Toothbrush, toothpaste, comb and brush, hair clips, pens, lined paper in journal or notebook, stickers, gloves, beanies, bag of marbles, bracelet, hot wheels or matchbox or hot wheel cars, little green men or cowboys in little bags, stuffed animals, small Lego type blocks, sunglasses.
