Ash Wednesday is February 22nd. Please remember that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence from meat is required for Catholics from age 14 onwards. Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own Church.
