### **PB & J+ Ministry**

A parishioner at OLM has been preparing and delivering sack lunches for the Ashland homeless each Wednesday for over a year. She prepares between 25-30 lunches each week and makes several stops through town to deliver them personally. A typical lunch consists of a

- peanut butter & jelly sandwich
- > fruit cup
- > soft cookie or candy
- Goldfish crackers or soft granola bar
- piece of fresh fruit
- bottle of water

Although the St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry in Medford has helped with some of the items, the increased costs and realized need have made it evident that she could use some help with this corporal work of mercy. We are inviting parishioners who want to participate in this ministry to help purchase supplies. Each month a list of needed supplies will be posted to the St. Vincent de Paul bulletin board in the breezeway, with a slot for sign-ups.

A typical list would include a selection of the following:

- ✓ brown paper lunch sacks
- ✓ plastic sandwich bags
- ✓ Plastic spoons
- ✓ Napkins
- ✓ Cases of water
- ✓ Fresh fruit: apples, oranges, etc.
- ✓ Granola Bars
- ✓ Cookies/candy
- ✓ Goldfish crackers individually wrapped packets at Costco are cheapest.
- ✓ Creamy Peanut Butter (many of the homeless have few or no teeth)
- ✓ Jelly preferably grape rather than seeded.
- ✓ Individual fruit cups like applesauce or orange segments
- ✓ Individually wrapped cheese packets
- ✓ Any snack type food that does not require refrigeration.


