My name is Shawn Raymond Daniel, and I'm thrilled to have Our Lady of the Mountain as my summer assignment for 2023!

I'm a convert; I was raised as a Protestant. The Catholic Church had not been "on my radar" at all until the young daughters (ages five and two-and-a-half) of a friend of mine repeatedly insisted I come to Mass with them. I had become something of a father-figure to them, and I in turn came to think of them as my "adopted kids," and loved them both very much. As I spent much time with them every week, the girls also wanted me to come to Mass with them, which at first I declined. After repeated requests, they prevailed, and I joined them for my first Catholic Mass and ended up attending most Sunday Masses with the girls over the course of the next four to four-and-a-half years. A "take-away" from my conversion story is to never underestimate the power of children, as their love helped change my life, and put me on the course that I'm on now.

Deacon Anthony Hoangphan was born in 1976 in Saigon, Viet Nam. He came to Portland in 1995. He graduated from Portland State University in 2001 with a degree in Information Systems and worked in Information Technology for 15+ years. While volunteering as a youth leader at Saint Anthony parish in Tigard, OR, he discerned the priestly vocation and entered Mount Angel Seminary in 2016, studying for Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon.

During his Seminary formational years, Deacon Anthony served in his summer assignments at St. Rose of Lima parish in Portland, St. John the Apostle parish in Oregon City, and St. Joseph parish in Salem. He spent his pastoral year at St. Anne parish in Grants Pass. He served as a transitional Deacon at Saint Paul parish in Saint Paul in his summer assignment and at Saint Rose of Lima parish in Portland in his last year of seminary formation.



Deacon Matthew Knight was born and raised in Roseburg, Oregon. He will be graduating from St. Patrick's Seminary & University in Menlo Park, California on May 12th.

Deacon Knight discerned a call to priesthood following his high school conversion to the Catholic faith. He served in parishes and schools across Oregon and California.

His interests include sacred music, literature, and Catholic anthropology and psychology. He will be ordained alongside Deacon Anthony and Deacon Efrain on June 3rd and looks forward to starting his priestly service in the Archdiocese of Portland this summer.
