Dear Parishioners,

Due to the recent changes made to the Adoration Chapel, I want to provide extra opportunities for Adoration with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the church. The first of these opportunities will be on the First Fridays of every month starting in October. Exposition will begin at the end of the daily 8:30am Mass and continue until 6 pm; at 6 pm we will have Benediction and the Blessed Sacrament will be reposed in the Tabernacle. Adoration with the Tabernacle doors closed may continue inside the Adoration chapel; contact the parish office for the code. In order to have First Friday Exposition inside the church, we **MUST** have at least two adorers signed up for every single hour that the Blessed Sacrament is exposed; if an adorer cannot make it for his or her hour, he or she is responsible for finding a substitute. There can be absolutely no exceptions to this rule. There can be no gaps in coverage. The Eucharist must **NEVER** be left alone, leaving the Body of Christ exposed on the altar. A sign-up sheet for October will be available in the breezeway; a new sign-up sheet will be available every month. All hours must be filled in order for this to happen; if there is a gap in coverage, we will proceed with the normal First Friday exposition instead. Please consider committing an hour to spend with Jesus.

Father Nghia Cao was born in Vietnam and has been in the United States for 37 years. He is a Redemptorist priest of the Denver Province and has been an ordained priest for 14 years. After finishing the philosophy program at St. John's Seminary College in Camarillo, CA, Fr. Cao earned a Master of Divinity degree from Catholic Theological Union in Chicago, IL. He served as parochial associate pastor at Holy Ghost Parish in Houston, TX as well as St. Mary's of the Assumption Parish in Whittier, CA.

In the mountainous regions of Sapa, N. Vietnam, Fr. Cao served as a missionary to the impoverished H'mong people. He served the H'mong people for 7 years raising funds for the many projects such as food, water, shelter, medical care, education, self-help programs, and emergency relief. He has spent the last 3 years assigned by his Provincial Superiors to the Liguori Mission House in the St. Louis area and is currently assigned to the Kansas City, MO Redemptorist Liguorian Magazine and parish missions.

Fr. Cao's heart is for all poor people everywhere and as God is willing, he is happy to work alongside Cross Catholic Outreach in service of our needy brothers and sisters.
