

Lenten Fasting Guidelines

All Catholics 14 years and older must abstain from meat on all Fridays of Lent, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. All Catholics ages 18 to 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. To fast means to eat one full meal; the other two meals being less than the normal amount unless they are already at a minimum for good health. No eating between meals, liquids are allowed.


