




Adoration, Confession and Stations of the Cross:



Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament — also known as **Eucharistic Adoration** — is the adoration of Jesus Christ present in the Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist is the body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus under the appearance of bread and wine. **Exposition** is the placement of the sacred host outside the Tabernacle for public adoration. *The Eucharist is described in the Catechism as the "source and summit" of our faith. Finding the time to go to Adoration can be difficult. But if you can make it happen, committing to regular Adoration with an open heart can have some surprising results.*
