Cross Catholic Outreach

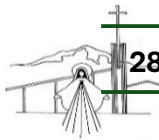

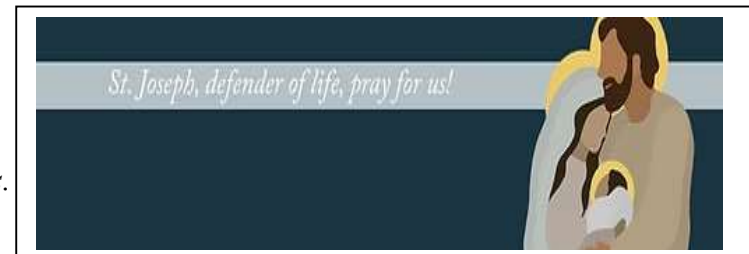

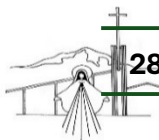

Cross Catholic Outreach This Weekend

Please welcome Fr. Carlos Chavez, he will be visiting our parish this weekend to speak at all the Masses on behalf of Cross Catholic Outreach, which was founded to forge a stronger and more supportive link between parishes in America and the priests and nuns serving the poor in the Caribbean, Africa, Southeast Asia, and Central and South America. Please be generous in your response to Fr. Chavez’s appeal. Brochures will be provided if you wish to support this worthy Catholic ministry.

Father Carlos Chavez, a native New Mexican born in Socorro, was ordained at St. Francis Cathedral, Santa Fe, in 1984. He served as the pastor of Sacred Heart in Clovis, NM, for 23 years and as a parochial vicar in various parishes and ministries within the Archdiocese of Santa Fe during his 30 years of ordained ministry. Inspired by his grandmother’s teachings to care for the poor, he felt called to the priesthood at 17. These lessons shaped his understanding of priesthood as a life of service, sacrifice, and joy in proclaiming Christ’s truth. He emphasizes that Christians must embody the Eucharist in their lives, as St. Augustine taught. Fr. Chavez states, “The mission of Cross Catholic Outreach is at the heart of who I am as a Catholic priest.”
