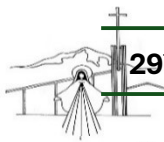

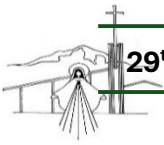

This year we assisted over 1100 people with over 700 visits. We helped 19 households get into housing. Our assistance primarily focused on keeping people housed but extended to many other areas. The “other needs” mentioned below encompassed birth certificates, camping supplies, clothing, food, DLs and IDs, storage, and phone bills.

Because we are all volunteers, our organizational expenses represent only .5% of our expenses. *Our transition to monthly collections from parishioners helped offset the reduction in grant support.* Your generosity has had a direct impact on our community!
