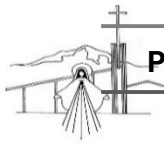

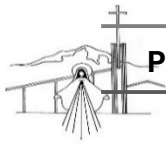
GOOD FRIDAY GUIDANCE**Remember, Good Friday is one of two required days of fasting and abstinence.****Guidelines in the Catholic Church are as follows:**

Catholics 14 years and older are required to abstain from meat

Fasting is obligatory for Catholics age 18 to 59

Fasting is defined as 1 full meal and 2 smaller meals not equal to the full meal

Children, those who are ill, and nursing/pregnant women are exempt from fast restrictions



Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available 24 hours a day in the Adoration Chapel. Come to the office in-person to obtain the key code!
