

Last month, our parish contributed \$3,981.10 to St. Vincent de Paul's treasury. That's enough to assist at least 13 households with utilities or 8 households with rent!

Established over thirty years ago, we have no paid employees and rely on volunteers to deliver our services, including bilingual volunteers who assist with non-English speakers.

Since the start of our fiscal year in October, we've helped **839 people (601 adults, 238 children) in 442 households**. This is a nearly **10% increase** from the same period last year, up from 765 people (549 adults, 216 children). This growing need is occurring at the same time as a reduction in available grants.

## **Mission Statement**

Our Ashland/Talent Conference of St. Vincent de Paul is dedicated to providing compassionate, prompt support and care to the poor and needy of Ashland and Talent, regardless of age, race, religion, creed, sex, sexual preference, or ethnic origin. Established over thirty years ago, we have no paid employees and rely on volunteers to deliver our services, including bilingual volunteers who assist with non-English speakers. All of the funds we obtain (with the exception of the cost of maintaining a phone helpline) are used to help those in need. We meet people anywhere that is convenient for them such as their home, public places, or by phone. Our volunteers meet with clients in teams of two and set aside as much time as needed to listen carefully to people's needs and assess what we can provide for rent, rental deposits, utility bills, medical expenses, car repairs, obtaining legal identification, and other items such as food and clothing. Funds are not given directly to clients but are instead paid directly to the source to which they are owed. We work closely with other non-profits and agencies to ensure clients get the complete services to which they are entitled, which often means connecting them with professional caseworkers. Compassionate care is a watch-word of our organization.

## **History**

Our Council was established in 1982 and has nine operating divisions or conferences, and the Ashland/Talent Home Visit Conference is one. One of the great strengths of our efforts is the variety of services we offer. The central Medford facility provides a forty-eight-bed family shelter, hot lunches for those in need five days a week, free groceries, and social services (counseling; rent, utility, and prescription drug payments; clothing; furnishings; camping equipment, etc.), in addition to school supplies, emergency dental care, health screening, hot showers, laundry facilities, and assistance in obtaining legal identification.

## **Procedure**

Requests for Ashland/Talent reach us through a telephone help line manned by volunteers from 10:00 AM until 4:00 PM five days a week. With our long track record, we are well known to other nonprofits who direct to us those in need. Because we do not wish to make anyone dependent upon our financial assistance, we set a limit for aid, allowing those seeking help with housing or utility payments to come to us once a year. Our volunteers meet twice each month to discuss our work and share strategies about individual cases. In addition to our St. Vincent de Paul Rule and Manual, each of our volunteers is provided with a seventeen-page booklet containing detailed information about other sources of assistance for those in need, and this booklet is updated regularly. We distribute a sheet in English and Spanish with information about community-wide services, contact information, and hours of operation. In short, we do everything we can to respect the dignity of the person and provide each one with the particular kind of assistance he/she or the family needs.
