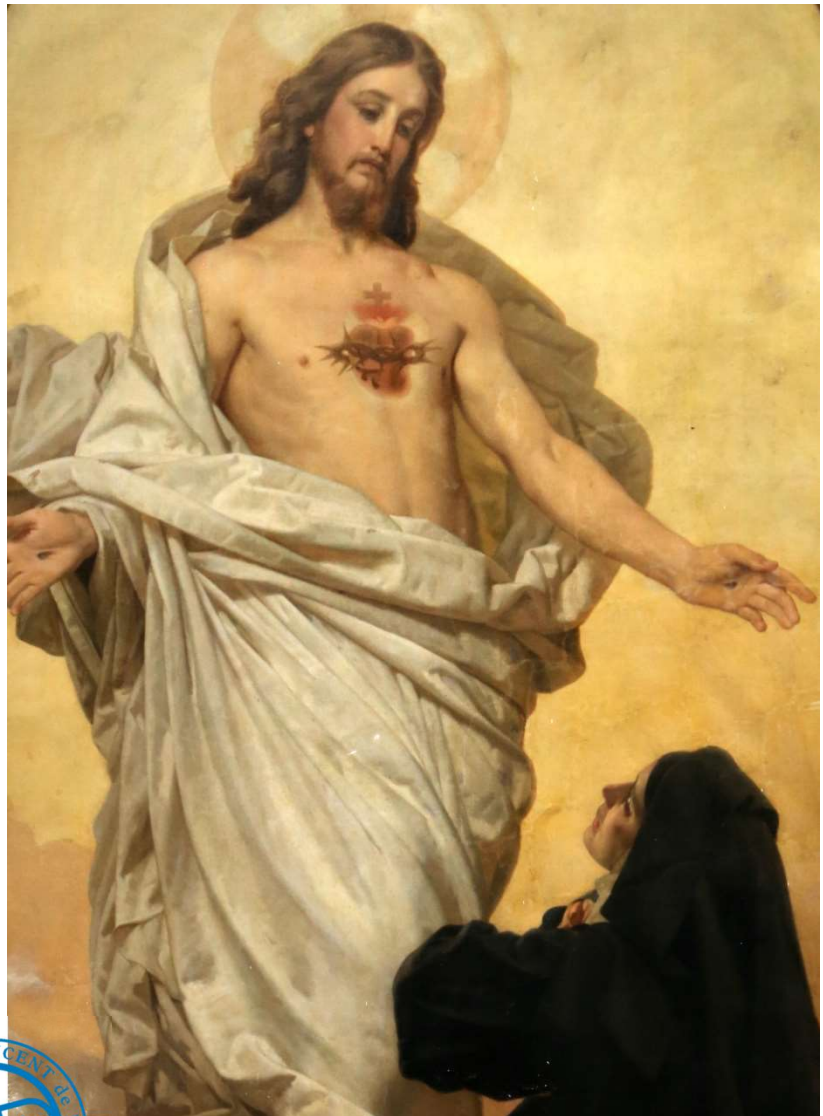

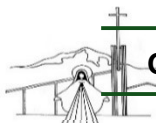

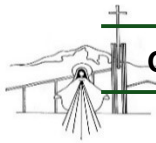
Religious Education: RE registrations open in August and classes resume in September. Have a blessed summer!

Newman: The Frassati young adult group will have meetings on Fridays. Reach out to Matt for more info on time and location.

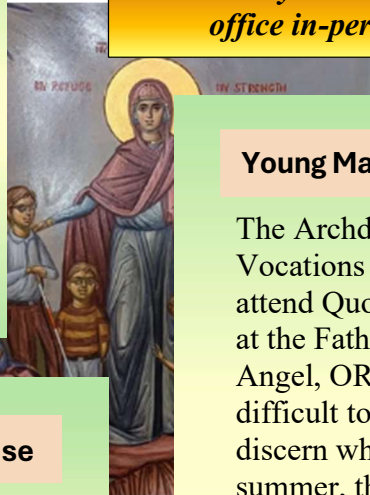
