

#### STORIES FROM SERVICE

A medical emergency or a job loss is most often the reason for a family to find itself seeking help. Just recently we helped a family in which the father was just coming out of rehab and looking for work. We were able to provide rental assistance for this family as they were dealing with their 18-month-old child who had already had 5 surgeries in her young life. (The tearful mother who called said they sometimes ran out of milk for the baby at the end of the month. The baby's grandmother had been helping with expenses, but at the time we received the call she was tapped out.) We were also able to help pay the utility bills for a disabled single mother without a phone (and help her obtain a free phone!)

## **Spiritual Service**

St. Vincent de Paul never wrote a book about his spiritual teachings, but we find the living voice of the saint in his letters and conferences in which he trained his followers for the mission of service to the poor. He wanted his followers to put the whole of the Gospel into the whole of their lives, and he never wearied of deepening both with all the faith that God put into his heart. That is why all that Vincent says to us has the simplicity of our everyday life and the penetrating strength of the Word of God. The SVDP USA Vincentian Weekly Reflections are therefore offered to all who strive to serve the poor in the spirit of St. Vincent de Paul, and that means you, too! The prayer and reflections are based on the Sunday Gospel of the Liturgical Calendar, together with the feast days of some of the saints of our Vincentian Family. Each reflection before an Ashland/Talent SVdP meeting offers a time for prayer, silence and discussion so that our everyday life, like Vincent, can become penetrated with the strength of the Word of God. In that spirit, enjoy this week's reflection with us!

## Reflection

Jesus teaches us that in our prayer God is our "Father" and just as a parent's love for their children is unlimited, so is God's love and care for us unlimited. Jesus further teaches that prayer unfolds in the context of this special relationship of "Our Father," it is not a kinship or progeny. "Father" is a metaphor used to describe our unique, intimate relationship with God. This relationship inspires us in us confidence with the realization that what we pray for is not so important as the fact that we address God in such intimate terms. Prayer always deepens our relationship with God and this is already an answer to what we need. (Living Liturgy, p.180)

## Meditation

"St. Teresa of Avila often could not finish the "Our Father" because she found that the first few words said everything. What a rich word, "Father." It brings to our minds what our own human fathers have done for us. When you say "father," you think of one who provides, and the great provider for us all is God: "Our Father, Who is in heaven." We can see many things wrong with the world, but it is good to think of what is right in the world. Who made the sun to rise this morning? Who gives us the fruits of the earth and the rains to soften the soil? Who feeds the birds of the air and clothes the lilies of the field? God, our Father. We could continue making a long list of the good and beautiful things we can see with our eyes or hear with our ears in this world of ours, and all of them have come from God: Our Father, Who is in heaven. Who told us all this? Jesus Christ. There are people who say that the most important truth that Jesus has taught us in the Gospels is that we have a Father in heaven and He is God." (McCullen, Deep Down Things, p. 471-2)

Question to meditate upon: How have you found in your life that indeed God is your "Father?"
