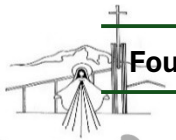

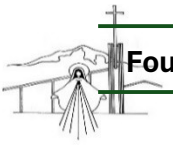

Guidelines for Lent Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday: Obligatory days for both fasting (one full meal, two smaller meals, no snacking) and abstinence from meat (for ages 14+).

Lenten Fridays: Obligatory day to abstain from meat (ages 14+).

Fasting (Ages 18-59): One full meal, plus two smaller meals that together don't equal a full meal; no snacking between meals.

Abstinence (Ages 14+): No meat (poultry, beef, pork, etc.). Fish, eggs, dairy, and grains are permitted.
