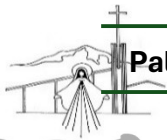

**RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

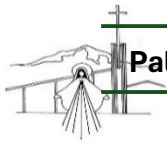
**Religious Education:** Religious Education classes are underway.

**Good Friday is one of two required days of fasting and abstinence.**

Fasting is defined as 1 full meal and 2 small meals (not equal to the full meal). Guidelines are as follows:

- Catholics 14 years and older are required to abstain from meat.
- Fasting is obligatory for Catholics age 18 to 59.
- Children, those who are ill, and nursing/pregnant women are exempt.

**Divine Mercy Novena**

The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday; there are leaflets on the table in the breezeway. At 3 PM on Divine Mercy Sunday, the first Sunday after Easter, there will be recitation of the Chaplet and Father will be available for confessions.

**This Week is Food Bank Sunday!**

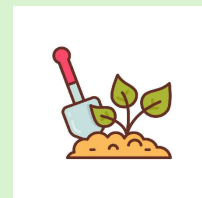
We invite you to leave your non-perishable food items in the marked food bin in the breezeway. Your kindness is helping feed and care for those in need in our community. We appreciate you!
