St. Vincent de Paul**Volunteer Opportunity in Ashland & Talent**

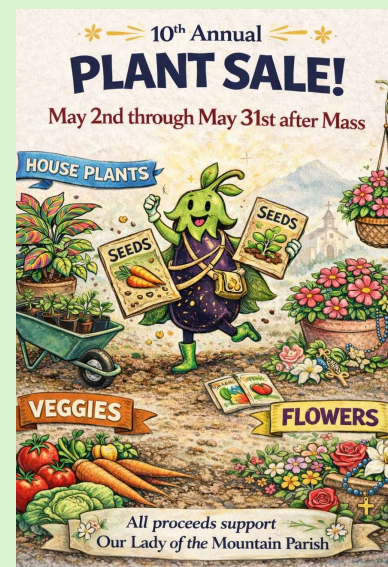
