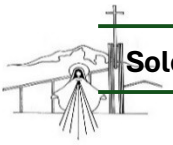

Sacred Heart prayer cards are available in the breezeway or can be downloaded at the link in the "Important Announcements" section of our website. To prepare for consecration of the Archdiocese to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we are being asked to pray this prayer daily from May 30th to June 7th.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available 24 hours a day in the Adoration Chapel. Come to the office in-person to obtain the key code!



There will not be Daily Masses, Confessions, or Adoration June 1st through the 4th. From Tuesday to Thursday, the Liturgy of the Hours will be prayed at the regular Mass times. **Services will resume on Friday, the 5th, and the First Saturday schedule will not be affected.**

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi

The solemnity of Corpus Christi will be celebrated on Sunday, June 7th. In addition to the procession in Portland, there will be a procession from Shepherd of the Valley in Central Point to Sacred Heart Parish in Medford; the procession will conclude with the Traditional Latin Mass. Check the websites of those parishes for more information. **Our Lady of the Mountain Parish will observe Corpus Christi with Eucharist Adoration and Exposition from 1 pm (after the Spanish Mass) until 4:30 pm (before the Sunday 5 pm Mass). There will be a sign-up sheet in the breezeway to make sure we have at least two people in the church while the Blessed Sacrament is exposed.**

On Saturday, June 20, four men will be ordained to the priesthood for the Archdiocese of Portland. Everyone is invited to attend. One of them is Deacon Shawn Daniel who served OLM as a seminarian a few years ago. The ordination will take place at the Cathedral in Portland at 11:00 am.
