

Would it not be a beautiful thing if Mary the Mother of God said that to you? Is it possible to obtain the gratitude of the Mother of God for all eternity? I think that it is possible, and in this essay I will try to prove my point. The teaching of the Church is that Mary is the Mediatrix of all Graces. This means that all the graces that Christ intends to give to each of us, He first gives to Mary, His Mother to distribute. In order to distribute these graces, she has to be aware of the needs of every human being. What does that mean? It means that in a spiritual sense she is mother of us all, since she has an important role to play in our spiritual growth, but no mother has ever loved as much as Mary, the Mother of God. Her love for each of us far surpasses all the love that our own mothers and the angels and saints combined have for us. The only one who loves us more would be Christ, who is both God and Man. Therefore, her concern for our spiritual and temporal welfare is so great that it is beyond our comprehension. Anyone who assists her in aiding those under her maternal care, which is each and everyone of us, **will have her profound gratitude**. They will have her gratitude because she would not have been able to accomplish many of the things that she desires to accomplish in our regard without our assistance. **She could say about many of her charitable works, "I couldn't have done them without you". Wow! My Blessed Mother is indebted to me!** Normally, we are indebted to her, and we will be for all eternity, because she shared in the redemptive work of our Lord Jesus Christ for our salvation. Is it possible for her to also become indebted to us?



It is true that after a mere word, a sigh, or a gesture from His Blessed Mother, our Lord is inclined to give her all that she requests, but greater than all these is the offering of the holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Nothing is as great on earth or in heaven as an offering of a Mass. If we were to give Our Lady the offering of a Holy Mass, what great things she could do in our regard. The mass transcends and far surpasses any other type of offering Mary could give her Son. She can do this when we go to a priest and say, "Father here is my stipend; I want a mass offered for our Blessed Mother Mary's intentions". In my Congregation of the Oblates of the Virgin Mary, every priest is given one Mass every month that he can celebrate for his own intentions. I have been favored, since my ordination, with the grace of giving that intention to Mary, the Mother of God. I have never regretted making that decision. What will our blessed Mother do with a Mass offering? Perhaps there is a soul in Purgatory whom she wants ardently to liberate and all this soul needs is the merits of a single Mass. This soul is soon freed from Purgatorial pains and enjoying eternal bliss because of the Mass that you gave to Mary for his release. What gratitude she will exhibit in your regard, to say nothing of gratitude of the liberated soul! There are many children in this world who are being abandoned, molested, and aborted. Every one of these children has the concern of Mary's Immaculate Heart. **Oh, what she could do with an offering of a mass for them; a Mass that you or I could provide.** We have mentioned nothing about those who are addicted to alcohol or drugs, or those who are in illicit sexual relationships, troubled marriages, and dysfunctional families; all these and more have our Blessed Mother's deep concern. Oh, what she could do with that offering of a Mass for them, and what gratitude she would show to those who assist her in this holy endeavor! May we be so blessed in giving her a mass intention.
