Saint of the Week

Saint Elizabeth of Hungary
1207 - 1231

Elizabeth was the daughter of the King of Hungary, and despite the opportunity she had to live a life of leisure and luxury, she chose instead one of penance and asceticism.

At the age of 14, Elizabeth was married and bore 3 children. After 6 years of marriage, her husband was killed in the Crusades which left her grief-stricken, but daily she would give bread to hundreds of the poorest in the land who came to her gate. Considered to be squandering the royal purse, her husband's parents threw her out of the palace only to be reinstated because of her son was legal heir to the throne.

At the age of 21, Elizabeth joined the Secular Franciscan Order, spending the remaining years of her life caring for the poor in a hospital she founded. She died in 1231 before her 24th birthday. <https://www.franciscanmedia.org/saint-of-the-day/saint-elizabeth-of-hungary/>

A Message from Our Pastor, Fr. Ted Dudzinski

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,



Pope Benedict XVI once wrote that the ways of the Lord are not comfortable. But, he continued, we are not created for comfort. We are created for greatness. In other words, we are created to be holy. Holiness means to live in friendship with God. It means that our wills are united with His, in good times and in bad, and that gives us the eternal joy of being loved and loving in return. And God asks us to *persevere* in that friendship, with the help of His grace. And today's readings highlight our call to be holy.

Before completing my article today, I want to share with you some key staffing updates that I believe flow from this call to holiness:

As many of you are aware our Director of Evangelization (DoE) position has been vacant since November 2024. Our Director of Operations (DoO) position had been vacant since June of 2024. Both positions had been advertised as available. Our present DoO, Rachel Witt, applied for the position of DoE. After our interview team interviewed her, we felt convinced that given her skillset and experience, we would ask her to consider our greater pastorate need at the time, the DoO position. She prayerfully discerned and graciously accepted that position. She has prayed and worked very hard to establish processes and helped bring a warm welcoming Christian presence to our pastorate. **I would like to announce the following staff positions effective December 1.**

Director of Evangelization- Rachel Witt, will spend December onboarding her replacement. I am grateful for Rachel's personal sacrifices over these past 11 months. Her encouraging, joy, and faith filled presence has helped us organize our office and create a wonderful Christian culture. I am very grateful for the efforts of Cherie Dejoie, Kendra & Kent Leckrone, Sue and Bill Bayley, our faithful volunteers, as well as Fathers Matthew, Joshua and Chris as well as Deacon Jim for their pastoral support in this area over the past year. Our ministry leaders continue to live out their discipleship during this vacancy, which inspires me and others to strive for holiness and share it with others.

Director of Operations- Chris Alter, effective December 1. Chris and his family are very active in our pastorate. Chris comes to us after 17 years as a previous co-owner and now manager of Exterior View Landscaping. We are very excited to welcome Chris, his positivity, joy, and faith filled presence to our pastorate staff.

Cemetery Sexton- Property Manager- Matt Emery, who will also take on pastorate property manager responsibilities, effective Monday, November 17. Matt is replacing, David Rebmann, who is retiring. We are grateful to David for his years of service. Matt has volunteered and assisted at our St. Mary Cemetery for the past year. Matt has varied life experiences, and is a joy filled man who is on his own faith journey. Matt desires to build upon the work of David and is excited to pour into this position with his background of mechanical and carpentry skills.

Exciting times as we move forward. I am excited to have a full team, by our possibilities and to see what God has in store for our pastorate. Please pray for all of our staff during this time of transition. In future bulletins, we will have photos and further introductions from Rachel, Chris, and Matt. After the first of the year, we will fine tune our organizational structure and share those results with our pastorate. Additionally, we are presently working on our new Pastorate Pastoral Council. Thank you to all who participated in our listening sessions. We will share those results soon.

Back to the beginning - God desires our friendship, our holiness, He will support us in all our ways as long as we keep trying to walk with Him. God is walking with us, and He asks us not to run from Him, but to run towards Him. (**As a reminder:** Our Chapel has extended hours. Just stop by or contact the pastorate office for the code.) We are called to holiness. And God, through today's readings, reminds us that our part is to keep trying to love. A saint, after all, is simply a sinner who keeps on trying.

We have been very fortunate through a collaboration with Fr. Richard Doerr to have been able to arrange for professional restoration by Autenrieb Murals and Statues in Edwardsville, IL. Transition to New Worship Aids

For the past year, our parish has been using *Breaking Bread* for congregational singing, and it has provided a fine selection of hymns and songs. However, the copyright license for *Breaking Bread* 2025 is valid only through the end of this liturgical year. Rather than purchasing new copies each year and discarding the old ones, we have chosen to develop and print our own worship aids.

These worship aids will include all the hymns and Mass settings for each weekend's liturgy, allowing parishioners to participate more fully in the celebration of the Mass without the need to turn multiple pages as in *Breaking Bread*.

In addition, this change will offer greater flexibility in selecting music through **One License**, enabling us to choose hymns that more closely align with the themes of the homily and the liturgical season.

The worship aids will also serve as a means of welcome and evangelization, offering visitors and newcomers a simple and accessible way to join in our sung prayer.

We'll start using these worship aids beginning the First Sunday of Advent, in conjunction with *Word & Eucharist*. We appreciate your understanding and support as we undertake this improvement, and we look forward to continuing our worship together in song and unity.

A Message from Fr. Joshua and Wendy Yuen

Dear Pastorate Family of Saint Mary Cathedral and Saint Ann Church,

I will begin this little message from the heart! **I miss you all very much!** Thank you all for being my family. **Also, thank you all for the Priesthood Sunday notes, gifts, and cards.** I received the package with all those items last week. I was overwhelmed by your words and kind sentiments in the many messages you sent me while I am away on deployment. **I am grateful to you all!**



Just yesterday, I was talking with a brother priest, Fr. Michael, who is also deployed in this part of the world. He is at a base in Jordan, and I am at a base in Kuwait. This is his very first deployment as a United States Air Force priest chaplain. He only had like two weeks to get out the door and now he is on a six month deployment. Welcome to the Military! (lol) Fr. Michael began his chaplain ministry about two years ago. He is a priest for the Archdiocese of New York near where my sister lives in upstate New York and he is the only priest in his diocese who serves in the Air Force. The other military priests in his archdiocese are all in the Army. Anyway, he left his home diocese to serve on active duty because we need more priests to serve in the military. He told me that he missed his parish family and was inquiring with me about the other options like the Air Force Reserves and the Air Guard. I told him I liked the Air Guard because I could serve full time for my Bishop and Diocese, while getting to serve part-time taking care of our Catholic service members and being a support to other military members as a chaplain. I will continue to talk with him and be a brother to him. I had never talked to him before yesterday, but it was like we had known each other for years. Please pray with me for all of the priests serving in our military especially those in deployed locations and overseas. The holidays are approaching and the service members deployed will need a lot of encouragement being away from their families and loved ones.

This weekend, we are approaching the end of a liturgical year with the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time and next weekend will be the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. The weekend after that, we begin the Liturgical Season of Advent that will help us prepare spiritually for Christmas.

Our opening collect prayer for this weekend states the following important words: “Grant us, we pray, O Lord our God, the constant gladness of being devoted to you, for it is full and lasting happiness to serve with constancy the author of all that is good.” This week, we are reminded of the important call from God and the Church to be a devoted people making sure that our faith is a priority and not just something that we will return to once in a while. We are called to a “constant gladness” in our devotion to Almighty God and to His Son Jesus Christ, our King. We are called to enjoy a “lasting happiness to serve with constancy the author of all that is good.” Are we praying every single day? Hmmm...


