

YEAR OF MERCY

Total Consecration to Jesus Through Mary





Pope Francis has declared a Jubilee Year of Mercy which begins on December 8th, 2015, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. Pope Francis invites us to take Mary as our example. Mary, a woman of faith, hope, and love; Mary who listens prayerfully; Mary ever guided by the Holy Spirit; Mary always obedient to the Father's will; Mary who teaches us how to give flesh to Christ in our world, how to be the "Church of Mercy."

You are invited to prepare for this phenomenal year by consecrating yourself to Jesus through Mary, using Fr. Michael Gaitley's 33 DAYS TO MORNING GLORY as a guide. This book reminds us of Mary's desire to bring us into the merciful Heart of her son.

The consecration starts on November 5th and is a 33 day "personal retreat" filled with prayer, reflection and learning, intended to bring us closer to Jesus, through a deeper relationship with His mother. It ends on December 8th with the celebration of the Mass, and a group prayer of consecration. This process can be done individually, as a family, or in small groups. Those who have done this previously are encouraged to repeat it, as the fruits of this experience are boundless.

Anointing
