Niceville Catholic Outreach



Our Redeemer and Holy Name of Jesus. We have been helping to provide for our neighbors in need for more than 35 years. We were named the Saint Vincent DePaul society for most of those years, and became "NCO" almost two years ago.

Our Patron Saint is Saint Mother Teresa of Calcutta. She has inspired us with her works of Charity, her Kindness to those in need, and her words of Wisdom: "Not all of us can do great things. But we can do small things with great love."

We have a food pantry and our office located at Holy Name, and we serve clients regardless of religious affiliation or race. The food pantry is stocked by donations from parishioners, such as we have done recently in the Knights of Columbus "40 cans for Lent drive" (Thank You) and the Thanksgiving and Christmas Dinner groceries drive; others, such as the Letter Carriers drive in May; and by the USDA food bank, "Feeding the Gulf Coast," in Milton FL.

In 2017 we served 1650 clients, and provided financial assistance to clients for rent, utilities, or other needs. We distributed food to 901 families, that is, 1370 grocery bags and approximately 25,000 pounds of food.

Next weekend, April 14th-15th, at Christ Our Redeemer, we will be having our quarterly collection for Niceville Catholic Outreach. As you come in to church you will notice envelopes with Saint Teresa's picture, those are the NCO donation envelopes. Please put your donation in the collection basket that day, or take the envelope home and bring it back for the next week's collection basket (or drop off at the Parish office).
